THE REPORT

The Department of Commerce, Morigaon College organized a one-day workshop on Career Awareness for the students of the Commerce department towards necessary certification in Banking Financial Services and Insurance (BFSI) sector. The primary aim of the program was to provide students with valuable insights into various career paths within the field of commerce and related industries. The program mainly targeted students from the B.Com 3rd and 5th semesters, offering them a platform to gain knowledge and understanding that extends beyond the boundaries of their academic curriculum. A total of 52 students actively participated in this session and also interacted with the resource person.

The session was formally started by Ms. Prashasti Bhattacharjee, faculty and programme coordinator at 11:30 am. Dr. Hemalata Sharma, Vice Principal, Morigaon College presented the welcome address. She highlighted the importance of skill enhancement among students which can widen their career scope in the future. The resource person- Mr. Sounok K Ghosh, Director and CEO of Projectibility Consultancy Pvt Ltd and Technical Advisor to KVIC-MoMSME was felicitated with an Assamese 'Gamusa' by Respected Vice Principal Dr. Hemalata Sharma. After that, he started the session by introducing the students with the importance of acquiring necessary skills and certification to be able to get placement in the BFSI sector. The BFSI sector has a huge number of vacancies out of which around 6000 apprenticeship positions have already been advertised. However, the number of skilled professionals required in this field are much less which is even more when it comes to the north-eastern states. Therefore, to address this skill gap, training programmes are necessary to ensure that students from the North-east get opportunity to join this sector. He highlighted the importance of skill enhancement courses and how possessing these skills will help the students in building their careers. His rich experience and expertise in this industry added immense value to the event. A wide range of topics were covered during the session, including finance, accounting, entrepreneurship, marketing, and management. He also shared real-world examples and case studies, illustrating the practical applications of commerce in different sectors.



The resource person, then talked about the details of the course offered by his organisation named the Skill Council Course which is recognised under Skill India Mission of the Government of India. The course will be a 100 hours job oriented programme designed for graduates or any student pursuing graduation. He ensured that undertaking this course will help the students to easily get entry level jobs with PSUs, banks or financial institutions.

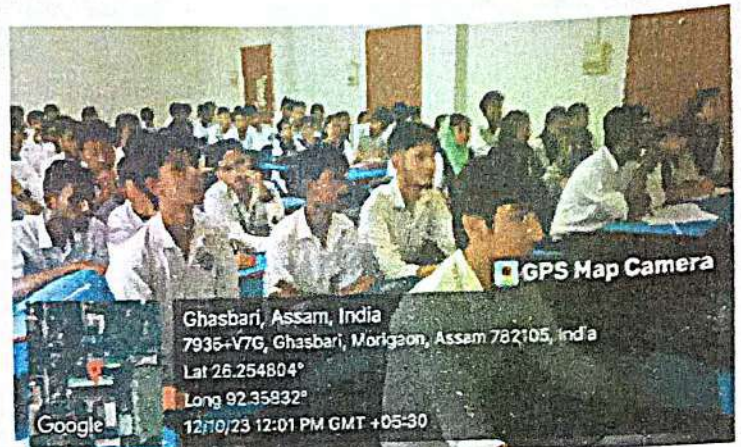
