



Report on a One-Day Workshop on Indian Knowledge System


Report:

A one-day workshop on "**Indian Knowledge System with Reference to Assamese Knowledge System**" was organised by the **Indian Knowledge System (IKS) Study Centre**, in collaboration with the **Department of History, Morigaon College**, on **25 February 2025**. The programme was held at the **New Conference Hall** from **3.15 pm onwards**. A total of **79 participants**, including students and faculty members, attended the workshop.

The workshop was conducted with the objective of creating academic awareness about the Indian Knowledge System, with special emphasis on the regional knowledge traditions of Assam. **Dr. Biman Hazarika, Principal, Dhing College, Nagaon**, served as the Resource Person. In his address, Dr. Hazarika highlighted the conceptual framework of the Indian Knowledge System and elaborated on the rich and diverse components of the **Assamese Knowledge System**, rooted in history, culture, and indigenous practices.

Special focus was given to the role of **Satras of Assam** as important centres of knowledge production and transmission. The Resource Person discussed traditional technologies and skills developed and practiced in Satras, particularly in the areas of **woodworking, manuscript writing, preservation techniques, artistic craftsmanship, and educational practices**. These discussions helped participants understand the scientific and technological dimensions embedded within indigenous Assamese traditions.

The workshop provided a structured academic platform for participants to engage with regional knowledge systems as integral components of the broader Indian Knowledge System. It also

facilitated critical reflection on the relevance of traditional knowledge in contemporary academic discourse.

Objectives of the Workshop:

1. To introduce the conceptual framework of the Indian Knowledge System with specific reference to the Assamese Knowledge System.
2. To create awareness about the technological and scientific practices embedded in Assamese traditions, particularly within the Satras of Assam.
3. To promote understanding of indigenous knowledge systems as valuable academic and cultural resources.

Outcome:

The workshop successfully met its stated objectives. Participants developed a clearer understanding of the Indian Knowledge System and gained enhanced awareness of the **Assamese Knowledge System**, especially the traditional technologies practiced in the Satras, such as woodworking, manuscript preparation, and preservation methods. The programme contributed to strengthening academic interest in indigenous knowledge traditions and their relevance in historical and interdisciplinary studies.
