**Brief Overview of the Program:**

A special awareness programme on “Cyber Law, Cyber Crime Prevention and Digital Safety especially for Youth” with a focus on youth and students was organized at Morigaon College (Autonomous). The programme aimed to educate students about safe online behaviour, existing legal protections, and preventive measures against cyber threats.

Before the formal inauguration of the event, a quiz competition on cyber safety and digital awareness was conducted for students to assess and enhance their understanding of the digital landscape. The quiz witnessed enthusiastic participation and helped set an engaging tone for the programme.

The session began with a warm welcome to the invited resource persons, followed by an introduction to the need for cyber awareness in today’s technology-driven world. A series of insightful talks were delivered by experts from various fields, each addressing critical aspects of cyber safety, law, and social protection.

APS Officer SK Sajidur Islam delivered an impactful talk on cybercrime, drawing from his professional experience in law enforcement. He explained various forms of cybercrime such as

online fraud, identity theft, phishing, cyberbullying, and misuse of social media platforms. Through real-life examples, he highlighted how youth often fall prey to digital scams and stressed the importance of responsible internet usage, strong passwords, and timely reporting of cyber offenses.

Advocate Niranjana Baruah addressed the legal framework surrounding cyber safety. He elaborated on the laws and legal provisions that ensure the security and protection of individuals in the digital space, including sections of the IT Act, IPC, and other relevant acts. He emphasized the rights of citizens, steps to take when cybercrimes occur, and the importance of being legally informed in order to take timely action.

Maitreyee Saikia spoke on the prevention of girl child marriage, connecting the issue to online vulnerability. She explained how digital platforms can sometimes expose minors to risks and highlighted the need for vigilance by families, educators, and communities. She discussed mechanisms for reporting child-related crimes and the vital role of the child protection unit in safeguarding minors from both offline and online exploitation.

Representatives from the District Legal Services Authority, Pankaj Kumar Nath and Bimal Das, informed students about free legal services available to citizens, especially vulnerable groups. They emphasized the importance of legal literacy and encouraged students to approach the DLSA for assistance in cases involving cybercrime, harassment, or violation of digital rights. Their session also highlighted government initiatives and helplines designed to support victims of digital offenses.

### **Key Learning:**

1. Understanding of different types of cybercrimes and how youth often become targets of online fraud, scams, and harassment.
2. Awareness of legal frameworks and security laws, including rights, reporting mechanisms, and the role of legal authorities in providing support.
3. Knowledge of digital safety practices, such as strong passwords, careful sharing of personal information, and identifying suspicious online activities.
4. Insight into child protection mechanisms, including how online platforms may expose minors to risks and how communities can safeguard children.

  - ii. CERT-In (Indian Computer Emergency Response Team): For reporting cyber incidents and guidance.
