Report:

The Department of Economics, Morigaon College in collaboration with the SDF, Golaghat, Assam has organized a one day National Workshop on **“Empowering Communities: The Role of NGOs in Livelihood Opportunities and Local Resource Management”** on 17th March, 2025 at 11.00 AM in the HS Sarma Memorial Seminar Hall. **Mr. Dhruba Jyoti Bora**, Chairman, SDF, Golaghat, Assam was the resource person. The workshop was chaired by Mr. Hemanta Kumar Das, Vice-Chairman of SDF. Dr. Chandan Sharma, Assistant Professor of Economics welcomes all the participants to the workshop and expressed the objectives of the workshop. The inaugural speech was given by Mr. Parag Jyoti Mahanta, General Secretary, ACTA. Mr. Bora elaborately discussed about livelihood opportunities by utilizing local resources, community participation in mitigating man-animal conflict, protecting bio-diversity, entrepreneurship development by youth, how students should prepare for livelihood opportunities etc. He emphasized that students must keep ready Plan B while preparing for competitive examinations. That Plan B is the entrepreneurship development by utilizing local resources at micro level. He also elaborately discussed about the necessity of disciplined banking habits. For institutional financing to start a business one must keep his CIBIL score in order. His participatory delivery benefited the students lot, as evident from the active interaction of the participants specially the students. They asked various questions regarding how to start a business and its management. Altogether 28 have participated.

Outcome:

- (a) The participants know about the preliminaries of undertaking entrepreneurship.
- (b) They are empowered with the necessity of protecting the local resources as well as its commercial uses without harming the bio-diversity.
