

Report on a Field Trip to Tezpur, Assam

Report:

A one-day field trip to Tezpur for students of 1st Semester, Dept. of History, Morigaon College, was undertaken on 21st of November, 2024. Ms.Suman Das and Raj Ballav Nath, Asst. Professors, Dept. of History, Morigaon College, were the teachers-in-charge for the field trip. A total of 48 students were taken to Tezpur for their SEC Field Trip.

The field trip aimed to provide students with first-hand exposure to the rich historical and cultural heritage of Tezpur, which has played a significant role in the ancient and medieval history of Assam. During the visit, students explored important historical sites and monuments, enabling them to relate classroom learning with real historical evidence. The guide explained the historical background, architectural features, and cultural significance of the sites, which enhanced the students' understanding of regional history.
