TOTAL PARTICIPANT: 25 numbers of students of Major course participated in the event. Students were accompanied by Two guide Teachers



Unlike class room learning, field work allows anthropology students to directly engage with the people and communities they study, making theoretical concepts more concrete and meaningful. With this aim and objectives in mind the Department of Anthropology of Morigaon college organized Field work for five days that is from 8th April 2025 to 12th April 2025 in a village named Morakolong, in Morigaon district, Assam. The community which was undertaken for study purpose is Tiwa community. Different topics were given among the students to have a holistic study of the area and the community. The topics that were given among the students were-Role of women in the family, Marriage its rules and regulation, Rites and rituals related to death, Rites and rituals related to birth, Family system, Festivals and fairs of the village, Rites and rituals related to puberty, Rites and rituals related to agriculture and fishing, Ethno-medicine practices, Psycho-social study of elderly, Roles and problems of elderly person in the family, Economic life of the village, Division of Labour, Role of Man in the family and village Religious beliefs and practices, Food habits and Dress and ornament. The above topics covers almost all the socio-cultural aspects of Tiwa community.

OUTCOMES OF THE EVENT: Students learn and will apply the basic and essential research techniques such as participant observation, interviewing, note taking and data analysis. By living and interacting with the local people of Morakolong, students will develop empathy, respect and deeper awareness of cultural diversity. Field work is not just a course requirement. 
