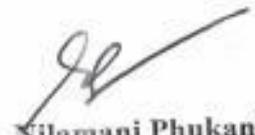

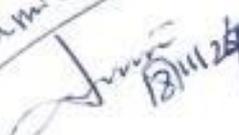

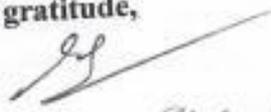

**Outcome:** Our students interacted with their doubts and queries and found this workshop so much helpful for them. The event was enjoyable and profitable for all.

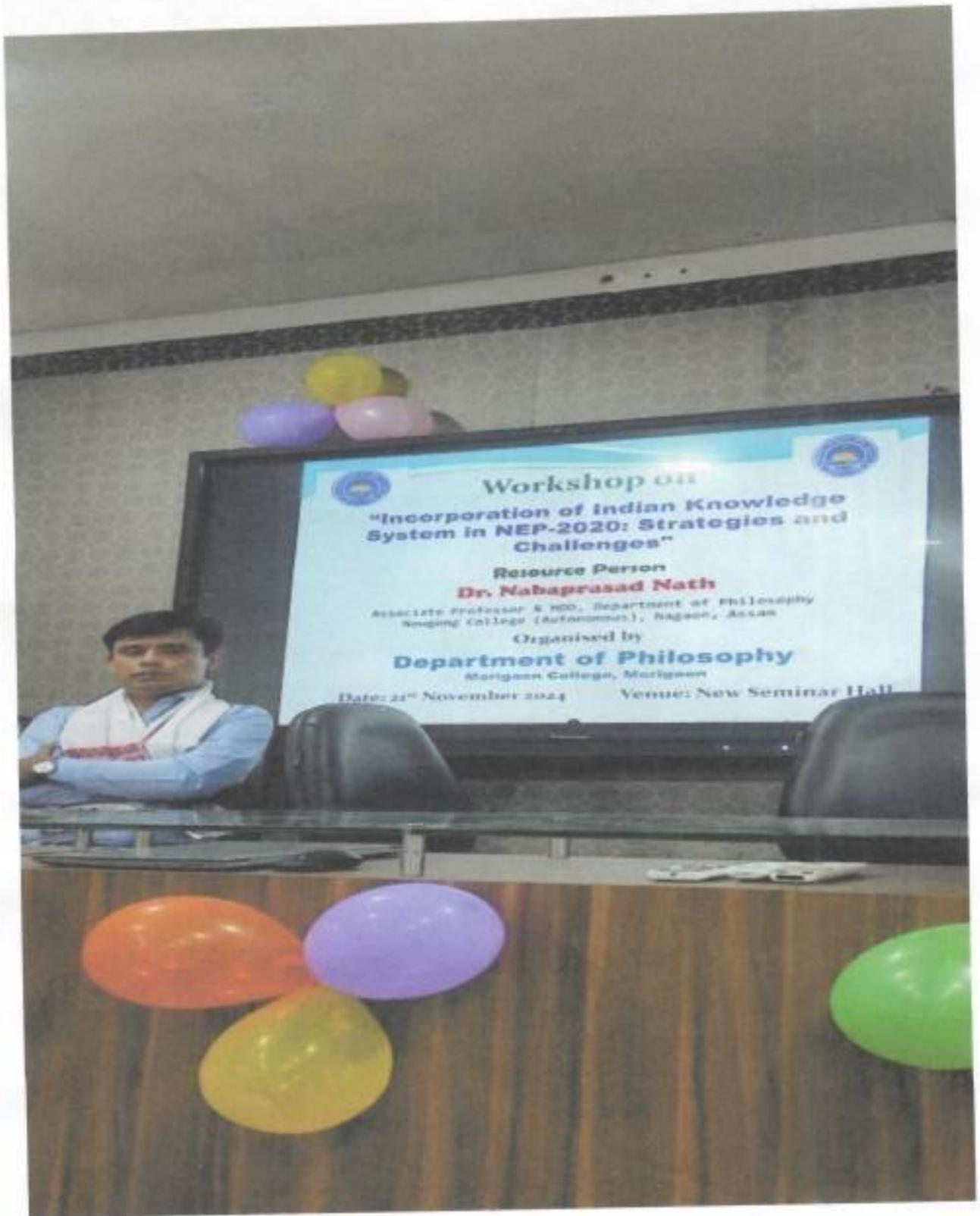
At the end, the vote of thanks was given by HOD Dr. Nilamani Phukan and the event had a successful completion.
