

**OBJECTIVES OF THE EVENT:** Aims to provide firsthand experience in research, promote deep engagement with studied communities and foster critical skill essential to the discipline.

**TOTAL PARTICIPANT:** 45 numbers of students of both Major & Minor course participated in the event. Students were accompanied by Two guide Teachers

**DETAILS OF THE EVENTS:** The project aims to understand the socio-demographic characteristics of Tiwa community of Tengaguri Village, located in Morigaon district of Assam. As Anthropology involves a holistic study of human population this field-based project enabled students to apply theoretical knowledge in real life community settings. This field work was conducted on 10<sup>th</sup> April 2025. This project work was undertaken by 2<sup>nd</sup> semester students having the skill paper – techniques in Social research. In this field work students collect demographic data such as age, sex, education, occupation and marital status. They also document cultural practices related to kinship marriage and health. The population of Tengaguri village shows characteristics of a transitional society with increasing literacy and awareness but also challenges like youth migration, low income and dependence on agriculture. Cultural traditions remain strong and play a significant role in social organization. The population study provided valuable insight into the demographic and cultural fabric of Tengaguri village. It helped students understand the interconnectedness of biological, social and cultural aspects of human population.

**OUTCOME OF THE EVENT:** The outcome of this experience among the students result in personal and professional growth, greater cultural understanding and the development of essential anthropological competencies
